

Guidelines for riding deadhead buses serving Utah County

Buses serving Utah County are always in service while on the road. If buses are returning to the garage or leaving the garage to start a trip, they are considered 'deadheading' and can be used to transport passengers. Here are a few guidelines that must be followed to make this work for the customer, the operator, and the schedule. Please refer to and follow the instructions listed here.

1. Information about dead head bus trips is only posted here on the UTA Website rideuta.com under the Timpanogos Division (Utah County).
2. Dead heading buses are not listed on a schedule for a reason. Dead Head bus trips **are subject to change at any time and not guaranteed** from one change day to the next.
3. If you desire to use the dead heading buses serving Utah County please send request to jwhicker@rideuta.com . Let us know your travel window and UTA will try to answer your inquiries as quickly as possible.
4. Due to ever changing operational requirements, weather conditions, road conditions, and other incidental happenings we are sorry we cannot publish a written schedule for dead heading buses. The times below are the best estimation we can provide.
5. Deadheading buses will not be 'HELD' for any passenger. It is your responsibility to be there with sufficient time to catch the bus. Buses will not detour to pickup or drop off passengers, you may get on/off at the garage and any stop on the buses regular route.
6. Public parking is not available at the Timpanogos garage in Orem.
7. Windows of opportunity for dead heading buses:
