UTA **Construction Notice**

Road Closure at 300 W and TRAX Red, Blue, & Green Lines between Ballpark, Meadowbrook, and River Trail

Construction: Saturday, August 10 - Thursday, August 15 Bus Bridge: Saturday, August 10 - Thursday, August 15

UTA will be performing maintenance on the TRAX Red, Blue, and Green Lines at the rail interchange at Central Pointe in Salt Lake from August 10 - August 15, 2024. During this time the Central Pointe station will be closed. A bus bridge will be in place from Meadowbrook to Ballpark stations for the Blue and Red Lines and River Trail to Ballpark stations for the Green Line. In addition, the bus bridges will have a stop at Central Pointe and Meadowbrook stations between these locations. Riders are advised to begin their trip at the Meadowbrook, Ballpark, and River Trail stations to avoid delays. Expect extensive delays. Regular TRAX service will resume on Friday, August 16.


Drivers (Saturday, August 10 - Thursday, August 15)

- Road closure on 300 W between 2700 S and SR-201
- Use W Haven Ave or SR-201 between 300 W

Riders (Saturday, August 10 - Thursday, August 15)

Red, Blue, and Green Line Bus Bridge between Meadowbrook, Millcreek, Central Pointe, and Ballpark stations for the Red and Blue Lines, and another bus bridge between River Trail, Central Pointe, and Ballpark stations for the Green Line.

- A bus bridge is a service UTA provides to allow passengers to ride a bus from one TRAX station to another while some stations are closed for construction.
- Bus bridges pick up and drop off passengers for the bus bridges at Ballpark, Central Pointe, Millcreek, Meadowbrook, and River Trail TRAX stations.
- Expect extensive delays during construction.
